



Happy Anniversary, Gene & Georgetti!

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Chicago's oldest steakhouse, [Gene & Georgetti](#) in River North, celebrates its 70th anniversary Thursday, July 14, through Saturday, July 16, with three days of throwback menus at 1941 prices — lunch or dinner with two cocktails for just \$15.25 per person. Entree choices consist of 12-ounce striplion steak, 8-ounce filet mignon, center-cut pork chop, chicken Vesuvio, broiled whitefish or mostaccioli or spaghetti with meat sauce.

The prix-fixe menu will be served from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m., and 1940s-style entertainment begins nightly at 6 p.m. Reservations are required: call between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Proceeds partly benefit Common Threads, Standing Tall and St.Vincent DePaul Center.

Gene Michelotti and his partner, **Alfredo "Georgetti" Federighi**, founded their namesake steakhouse in 1941, and it's still run by Michelotti's daughter, **Marion**, and her husband, **Tony Durpetti**, now with help from their daughter, **Michelle**.
